“Submission Guidelines for the teams selected for the final event to be held in INAE Youth Conclave during 10th-12th August, 2018 at IIT, Kharagpur”

The team should not deviate from their stated goals and objectives as submitted and presented during the pre-conclave meet. Any major deviation will lead to disqualification of the team.

Submission Deadline: 20th July 2018

Conclave Report and Evaluation Requirements:

Apart from Pre-conclave problem statement, team should address the following points for the Conclave in the revised document.

- Clear specification of where a team would present typical only **one specialization curriculum structure** along with the detail and with proper justification for proposed subjects
- Setting any **objective criteria to meet in the curriculum** and **asking for the analysis in support of any claim.**
- Proposed curriculum, asking for a **detailed syllabus of the course along with references.**
- **Possible benefits** of the proposed curriculum – How the proposed curriculum addresses all the possible career prospects (e.g. Academics, Corporate, Management, Research, Industry etc.)

Report Preparation

1. Report making rules for case:
 - Report should be done in A4 sheets only.
 - Number of Pages in Report:
 - a) A cover page with the title, name of the team, Institution and names of participants
 - b) An Index page- 1+
 - c) Report Content – Maximum 100 pages

d) Annexure - In the first page of annexure nothing should be written except "Annexure". Watermark, header, footer can be added anywhere in the report including title pages. And note that any instance of plagiarism in essay or case report will lead to straight disqualification.

2. Penalty for crossing the report limits: (As mentioned in the Pre Conclave problem statement)

Important Note:

- The essay that was mentioned in the pre conclave is no more needed for the finals.
- In the final report for the conclave (10th - 12th August) you may reframe your answers to all the questions (a), (b), (c) and (d) [in the pre conclave problem statement] according to your updated work as per the above guidelines. But answering to all these 4 questions in the final report is mandatory.
